Members were asked to complete the top of one sheet for each item they are donating and add a starting bid. Regina Swygert announced that Mary Hartfield will teach an oil project at the November meeting. The annual Christmas ornament exchange will be held during November meeting. Each member who wishes to participate should bring seven painted ornaments. Six will be exchanged and the seventh will be donated to the Cayce-West Columbia Library.

Debbie Jordan stated that normally, the "entrance fee" to the Christmas party is an ornament to be exchanged during the party. She asked if, since we are holding the ornament exchange in November, the members would like to bring a memory
