If you order much on the Internet, you should check out Ebates.com. My daughter, Katie, told me about EBates.com in October. She had checked it out and had been using it. I have been using it since then, and I have already earned a rebate check. Here's a little information from the EBates site.

"Shop through Ebates, and earn up to 25% cash back at your favorite stores. How? Our stores pay us a fee when you shop. We then share the fee directly with you - it's just that simple. We never charge a membership fee or require mail-in rebate forms. We just send you your cash, no strings attached." Once you have registered on EBates, you simply go to EBates.com, login, and then click the site at which you want to make a purchase.

Rebate checks are sent 4 times a year; you get a check if you have earned at least \$5. Now, if they only had art suppliers on the list!

PUMPKIN COBLER

from Gooseberry Patch Classics

3 eggs, beaten	1 tsp. ground ginger
15 oz. can pumpkin	1 tbs. vanilla extract
12 oz. evaporated milk	1 c sugar
1/8 tsp salt	1 1/2 tsp. cinnamon

1 1/4 c margarine, melted (I used butter, been listening to too much P. Deen)
 18 1/4 oz. pkg. yellow cake mix
 1 c chopped nuts

Mix the first 8 ingredients together; pour into an ungreased 13x9 baking pan. Sprinkle cake mix over the top; drizzle with margarine. Bake 350 degrees for 25 min.; top with nuts. Bake for an additional 15 min. Makes 15 to 18 servings.
